



Sergio Pininfarina has been awarded the “Foglio d’Oro 2004”

For his “intense entrepreneurial activity” Sergio Pininfarina has received the “Foglio D’Oro 2004” award in the Entrepreneurs’ Category. He was presented with the award on 12 November by Count Niccolò Caissotti di Chiusano, Chairman of the Italians Abroad Committee of the Principality of Monaco, during a gala evening held at the Hotel de Paris in Monte Carlo, compèred by Daniele Piombi and Simona Tagli. Besides the Chairman of the Pininfarina Group, the actress Ornella Muti received an award for her Artistic Career and Max Biaggi for Sport.

Now at its fifth edition, the “Foglio D’Oro 2004” award celebrates three important Italian personalities every year who have distinguished themselves in their respective professions.
